- When we lose who we are, we try to find it in what we do or who we do it with... and that never works. Nothing could be more disastrous for the world than God’s image bearers finding identity and belonging and even satisfaction apart from Him. The curse is God’s love in disguise that we might rely on him. How can you rely on God more in your work and allow frustrations be a doorway to connection with Him?
- Over the last three weeks, what has stood out to you most as you reflect on the messages and your own vocation? Is there anything you sense God is asking you to do in response?
